Thank you for offering your property for consideration. Be aware that as the trail project develops additional sites will be needed and at that time you should resubmit your property for consideration.

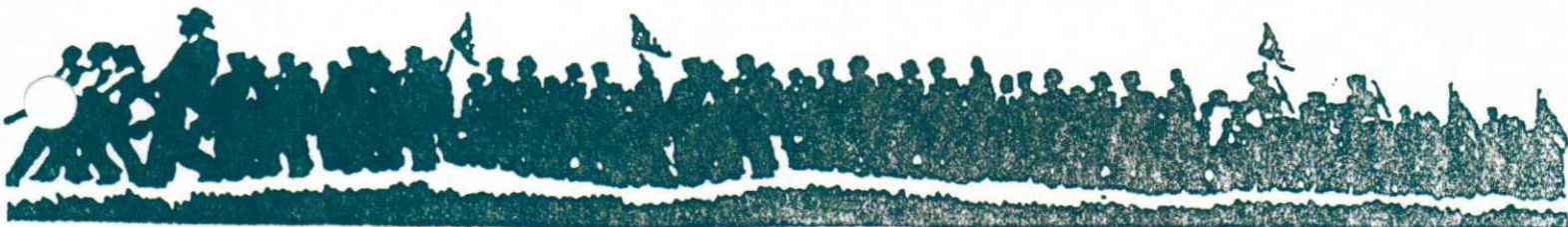

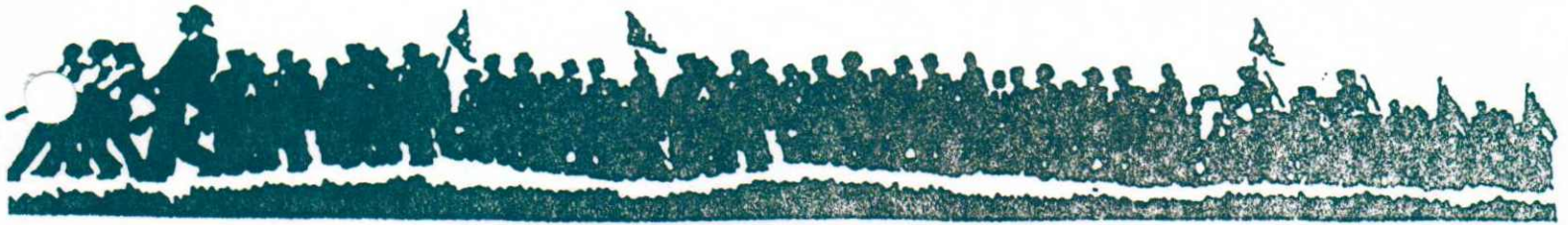
